Nebraska.gov will continue to highlight services on the homepage during certain months to help increase adoption for our state agencies and for the State of Nebraska.

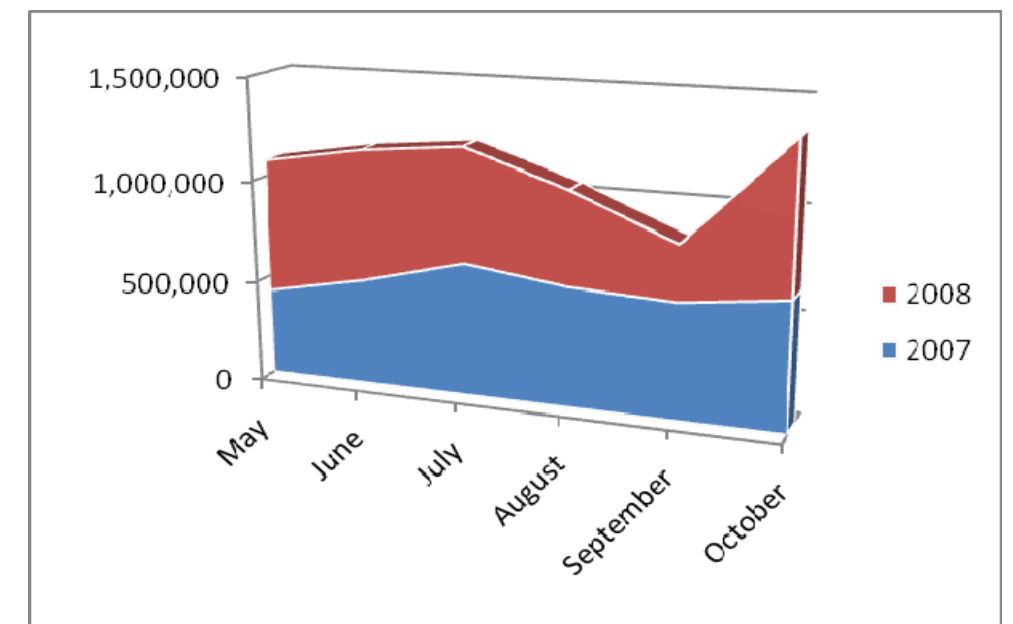

Driver License Reinstatements

For the current fiscal year, July 2008 to October 2008, there was a 53% online adoption rate.

The program was launched on January 24, 2008. Over \$1 million dollars has been collected using the online program.
