In accordance with the Notice of Disciplinary Action issued on October 27, 2017, by Thomas L. Williams, MD, Chief Medical Officer, Division of Public Health, Department of Health and Human Services, your original License to operate a Family Child Care Home I in the State of Nebraska has been placed on Probation. A license imprinted with the term "PROBATION" is enclosed. This status became effective November 14, 2017, and it will remain in effect until November 14, 2018. Upon completion of the Probation, a new license will be issued to you.

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LICENSING AGREEMENT

I, Lori Andersen, owner, hereby state and declare:

I am the owner of Andersen's Day Care, F15220, 1301 13th Street, Wisner, NE 68791.

I have read and understand the Regulations Governing Licensure of a Child Care Center, Title 391 Chapter 1 (CSL001).

I agree to comply with all the regulations governing licensure of Family Child Care Home I, effective May 20, 2013 as long as I am licensed by the State of Nebraska to provide child care services.

I understand and agree to comply with:

1-006.01 Licensee Qualifications and Requirements: The Family Child Care Home I licensee must:

7. Be in compliance with all regulations whenever any children are in care;

1-006.03C Household Members: For each household member, the licensee must:

3. Not allow any household member who engages in behavior injurious to or which may endanger the health or morals of children to provide care or be on the premises.

1-006.12A Supervision in the Absence of the Licensee: Any designated substitute has the same responsibility for providing adequate and appropriate supervision as the licensee. All parents, except in emergency situations, must be notified in advance of the use of a substitute supervisor.

1-006.14 Prohibited Language, Materials, and Actions: Children of any age must not be exposed to:

1. Profanity;

1-006.19 Transportation: When transportation is provided for children in care, the licensee must ensure the following conditions are met:

9. Written permission from parents for the program to transport children must be obtained, kept on file, and made available to the Department;

10. Children must not be transported to any location without the prior knowledge of the parent(s), except in a medical or other emergency

I understand and agree that during an unannounced annual inspection on February 2, 2017, Lori Andersen admitted to having issues with her son regarding using profanity in front of day care children. Lori Andersen will ensure that her son, Francis Bouska, will not be left alone with day care children at any time. Lori Andersen will ensure that her son, Francis Bouska, is always required to be on a different floor of the home separate from the day care children, during hours of licensed day care operation.

Lori Andersen also admitted to allowing her 17 year old son, Brett Andersen, to transport children to school, Lori Andersen did not have any signed written permission forms available for the Department to review. Lori Andersen did not notify parents of her 17 year old son, Brett Andersen, transporting children to school. Lori Anderson will obtain written documentation from all enrolled day care parents granting permission for her son, Brett Andersen, to transport children to and from school and other activities and keep with her day care records. Lori Andersen will also send documentation to Brenda Herring by March 1, 2017.

Lori Andersen admitted to allowing her 17 year old son, Brett Andersen, to provide care for enrolled day care children on occasion. Lori Andersen does not have Brett Andersen listed as a substitute and/or staff on her application for Family Child Care Home I. Lori Andersen will amend her license to include Brett Andersen as a substitutes and/or staff and conduct all required background checks and send copy to Brenda Herring by March 1, 2017. Lori Andersen must file her amended application for Family Child Care Home I with Central Office in Lincoln, Nebraska prior to March 1, 2017.

I agree that this Licensing Agreement will be prominently posted with my Family Child Care Home I License so that it is clearly visible to parents and agency representatives.

I understand that Children's Services Licensing staff shall conduct announced or unannounced visits to my program to determine compliance with this Agreement.

Any violation of this Agreement may be grounds for further negative action or discipline as the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, Licensure, Children's Services Licensing may deem appropriate.

This Agreement shall be in effect for six months from the signing after which time the Agreement will be reviewed and terminated, extended and/or modified. In addition, should a change of address occur or should I reapply for a different type of child care license, this Licensing Agreement may transfer to the new license and/or address if appropriate to the conditions of this Licensing Agreement.
