LICENSING AGREEMENT

I, Pauline Berumen, hereby state and declare:

I am the licensee of Paula's Day Care, FII6743, located at 1319 East 31st Street, Kearney, NE 68847.

I agree to comply with all the Regulations Governing Licensure of Family Child Care Home II, Effective May 20, 2013, as long as I am licensed by the State of Nebraska to provide child care services.

I understand this Agreement is based on observations made by a DHHS employee on January 5, 2018, and during a complaint investigation by Lori Altmaier on January 16, 2018, at which time the following violations were noted:

391 NAC 2-006.15B Beds, Cribs, and Sleeping Surfaces: "2. The only acceptable sleeping surfaces for children age 12 months and under are cribs and playpens. When used, cribs and playpens must meet the following standards:

c. Cribs and playpens must contain no soft objects, bumper pads, toys or loose bedding. If a blanket is used, it must be secured or tucked under the crib mattress or the pad of the playpen and reach no higher than the infant's chest,"

I understand and agree that safe sleep practices will be followed at all times. I understand and agree that under no circumstances will infants sleep in highchairs or bouncy seats. I also understand and agree that cribs and playpens will not contain loose bedding or toys.

I understand that Children's Services Licensing staff shall conduct announced or unannounced visits to my program to determine compliance with this Agreement.

I agree that this Licensing Agreement will be prominently posted with my Family Child Care Home II License so that it is clearly visible to parents and agency representatives.

Any violation of this Agreement may be grounds for further negative action or discipline as the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, Licensure, Children's Services Licensing may deem appropriate.

This Agreement shall be in effect from the signing of this Agreement for six months, at which time it will be reviewed by the Department to determine if this Agreement should be continued, revised or terminated. In addition, should a change of address occur or should I reapply for a different type of child care license, this Licensing Agreement may transfer to the new license and/or address if appropriate to the conditions of this Licensing Agreement.
