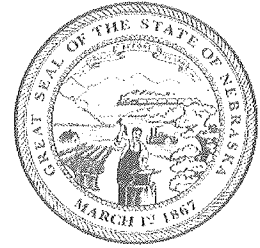

As soon as the licensee becomes aware of the occurrence, the licensee must notify the Department of any arrest, misdemeanor ticket other than a traffic violation, pending criminal charges, and any felony/misdemeanor convictions of him/herself, staff, volunteers, or household members. Failure to notify the Department of law enforcement contacts as described may result in disciplinary action.

NAC 391 1-008.01 Denial and Disciplinary Actions

The Department may deny the issuance of or take disciplinary action against a license on any of the following grounds: 4. Conduct or practices detrimental to the health or safety of an individual served by or employed at the program;


3. I understand and agrees that my initial charges of 2 counts of Terroristic Threats, Class IIIA Felony was amended to 2 counts of Carry Concealed Weapon, Class I Misdemeanor on 6-29-18 , I was convicted of that charge, and I was placed on 2 years probation.

4. I understand and agree with the following:


- A. I will report any and all Law Enforcement Contact to Children's Services Licensing within 24 hours or the next business day, attn. Stef Sellers,
- B. I will provide updated Criminal History to Stef Sellers on the following dates: 1-1-19; 7-1-19; 1-1-20; 7-1-20,
- C. This Agreement will be prominently posted with the current license so it is clearly visible to parents and Department representatives,
- D. All parents of children enrolled will receive a copy of this Interim Licensing Agreement within 24 hours and that documentation of each parent receipt will be maintained and available for review upon request,
- E. That the OCSL shall conduct announced or unannounced visits to my facility to determine compliance with this Agreement.

5. Any violation of this Agreement may be grounds for further negative action or discipline.

6. This Agreement shall be in effect from the signing date for 2 years. Should the license be amended because of a change of address, this Agreement may transfer to the new address if appropriate to the conditions of this Licensing Agreement.

<p><b>Allegations</b>                      On 12-18-17 CSL received an email from Resource Development notifying Licensing that they were terminating their contract with Alesha Dumas effective 12-14-17 due to not reporting current charges of Terroristic Threats. Rd reported that Alesha was charged with 2 counts of Terroristic Threats, Class IIIA Felony. One incident occurred on 7-28-17 and one incident occurred on 6-16-17. **Observation and Findings**

CCIS Stef Sellers was assigned the complaint inspection on 12-18-17

CCIS contacted Alesha Dumas on 12-18-17 and 12-19-17 regarding the above allegations. Alesha denied pointing a gun at anyone. Alesha indicates that she is not providing child care at this time.

1-3-18 Alesha had a court hearing this morning and was bound over to District Court on 2 counts of terroristic threats, class 3A Felony.

1-4-18 phone call from Alesha. Update from court date on 1-3-17. A Pretrial is set for 3-16-18

3-19-18 phone call from Alesha. Alesha indicates her pretrial was continued again to 4-13-18.

4-17-18 phone call from Alesha. Alesha states that her pretrial was continued to May 11, 2018.

5-11-18 phone call from Alesha. Alesha reports that the hearing was continued to June 15 at 9am.

6-15-18 hearing continued to 6-29-18.

7-2-18 phone call from Alesha. The initial charges of 2 counts of Terroristic Threats, Class IIIA Felony were amended to 2 counts of Carry Concealed Weapon, Class I Misdemeanor. Alesha received 2 years of Probation. CCIS verified the above information via NDEN.

- **Alesha did not report the current charges or the contact with Law Enforcement to Children's Services Licensing. Licensing became aware from another DHHS Dept.**
- **Alesha was initially charged with 2 counts of Terroristic Threats, Class IIIA Felony however; the charges were amended to 2 counts of Carry Concealed Weapon, Class I Misdemeanor.**

**CONCLUSION:**

Based on the information gathered, CCIS is substantiating a violation of regulations 1-006.02D as well as 1-008.01.
