Licensing Agreement

I, Ami Moore, Licensee of a Family Child care Home II, License Number FI9231. Located at 7406 Sun Valley Dr., Omaha, NE. 68157, hereby state and declare:

I have read and understand the Regulations governing licensure of a Family Child Care Home II, Title 391 NAC Chapter 2.

I agree to comply with each of the Family Child care Home II regulations as long as I am licensed by the State of Nebraska to provide child care services.

I understand and agree that the below stated regulations were in violation at an annual licensing inspection conducted on 06/05/2017, which resulted in an emergency suspension of my license.

On 06/13/2017 corrections were made, and the suspension was lifted.

2-006.01 Licensee Qualifications and Requirements: The Family Child Care Home II licensee must:

4. Be responsible for the day-to-day operation of the child care program.
7. Be in compliance with all regulations whenever any children are in care:

2-006.20G Storage:

1. All prescription and non-prescription medications must be kept in locked storage at all times children are in care;

2-006.22 Food Safety:

10. All utensils, equipment, and food storage areas must be kept clean and in good repair;

2-006.24 Environmental Services: The licensee must provide child care in a safe, clean, comfortable environment. Every area and building on the same premises used for child care must comply with the regulations.

2-006.24A Housekeeping and Maintenance:

5. All garbage and rubbish must be disposed of in a manner that minimizes odor and the transmission of infectious diseases, and prevents the attraction of rodents flies, and all other insects and vermin.

2-006.24B Maintenance of Materials:

1. The licensee must keep equipment, fixtures, furnishings, and toys used in the child care program clean, safe, and in good repair.

2-006.25 Environmental Safety: The license is responsible for maintaining a safe and hazard free environment.

2-007 Physical Plant Standards: The child care home must be maintained in a manner that is safe, clean, and functional for child care.

2-007.07 Fire Safety:

5. All storage area must be free of excessively cumbustable or highly flammable materials;

I understand and agree that I have responsibility to ensure compliance with regulations at all times children are in care.

I will ensure that this Licensing Agreement will be prominently posted with the current Child Care Center license so it is clearly visible to parents and Department representatives.

I understand that Children's Services Licensing staff may conduct announced or unannounced visits to my facility to determine compliance with this Agreement.

Any violation of this Agreement may be grounds for further negative action or discipline as the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, Children's Services Licensing may deem appropriate.

This Agreement shall be effective for a period of 6 months, from the date this Agreement is signed, August 15, 2017, until February 15, 2018.

Should the child care license be amended because of a change of address, this Agreement may transfer to the new address if appropriate to the conditions of this Licensing Agreement.

This matter comes for consideration on the Motion for Termination of Emergency Order and Protective Order and Lifting of Suspension filed by the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health.

The Director and Chief Medical Officer, having reviewed the Motion and accompanying Affidavit, finds as follows:

1. Ami Moore holds a Family Child Care Home II License to operate a child care program located at 7406 Sun Valley Dr., Bellevue, NE.

2. An emergency existed requiring immediate action to protect the physical well-being and safety of a child or children in the care of Ami Moore.

3. NEB. REV. STAT. § 71-1912 authorizes emergency orders to require such action be taken as the department deems necessary to meet the emergency.

4. Pursuant to an Emergency Order issued June 6, 2017, Moore's license was immediately suspended and she was ordered not to provide care for any child, except her own until she successfully passes an inspection by the Department to determine her compliance with the requirements to operate a Family Child Care Home II child care program.

5. Moore has now successfully passed an inspection by the Department to determine her compliance with the requirements to operate a Family Child Care Home II child care program, meeting the requirements of the June 6, 2017 Emergency Order.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

The June 6, 2017 Emergency Order and Protective Order is hereby terminated and the Suspension of Moore's license and prohibition on providing child care is lifted.

This matter comes for consideration on the Motion for an Emergency Order and Motion for Protective Order filed by the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health. The Director and Chief Medical Officer, having reviewed the Motion and accompanying Affidavits, finds as follows:

1. Ami Moore holds a Family Child Care Home II License to operate a child care program located at 7406 Sun Valley Dr., Bellevue, NE.
2. An emergency exists requiring immediate action to protect the physical well-being and safety of a child or children in the care of Ami Moore.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

- a. Pursuant to Nebraska Revised Statutes §71-1915, the child care license of Ami Moore is hereby and immediately Suspended and Ami Moore may not provide care for any child, except her own, until she successfully passes an inspection by the Department to determine Ms. Moore's compliance with the requirements to operate a Family Child Care Home II child care program.

Upon application to the Director within fifteen days of this Order, Ami Moore shall be afforded a hearing as soon as possible and within ten days of the application, unless she requests that the hearing be held later. Any such application should be addressed to: Rita Krusemark, for DHHS, Children's Services Licensing Licensure - Division of Public Health, P.O. Box 94986, Lincoln, NE 68509-4986

C. Any reference in this matter to any child enrolled in the above child care program shall be made by the use of the initial letters of the child's first and last name.

3. Any information which is confidential by state statute shall not be released to the public and any pictures of any children referred to in this matter shall not be released to the public.
