- I, Jeanne Lush, hereby state and declare:
 - 1. I am the director of the above-mentioned childcare program.
 - 2. I have read, understand and agree to comply with all the Regulations Governing Licensure of Child Care Centers, Title 391, as long as I am licensed by the State of Nebraska to provide child care services. Specifically,

391 NAC 3-006.19 Supervision of Children: "Adequate and appropriate supervision must be provided to children at all times children are in attendance, including during outdoor play. Ultimate responsibility for supervision rests with the licensee."

3. I understand that this agreement is based on the fact that the Office of Children's Services Licensing (OCSL) substantiated a violation of appropriate supervision, by self-report, where a 5 year old child care child was dropped off at the wrong school by Education Express on August 15, 2018. Education Express was not aware of this error, until the school notified the Education Express Director approximately 10 minutes after the child was dropped off, that he didn't attend school at that location.

- 4. I understand and agree with the following:
 - A. I will adequately and appropriately supervise all children in my care at all times.
 - B. This Agreement will be prominently posted with the current license so it is clearly visible to parents and Department representatives.
 - C. All parents of children enrolled will receive a copy of this Licensing Agreement within 24 hours and that documentation of each parent receipt will be maintained and available for review upon request.
 - D. That the OCSL shall conduct announced or unannounced visits to my facility to determine compliance with this Agreement
- 5. Any violation of this Agreement may be grounds for further negative action or discipline.
- 6. This Agreement shall be in effect from the signing date for 6 months. Should the license be amended because of a change of address, this Agreement may transfer to the new address if appropriate to the conditions of this Licensing Agreement.

Children's Services Licensing received an email from Jeanne Lush on 8-15-18 stating that on 8-15-18 a 5 year old school age child (BF) was dropped off at the wrong school. The school						
contacted Jeanne Lush at Education Express shortly after the drop off to let them know. Jeanne						
indicates that the van driver went back to the school and picked up the child and took him to the						
correct school. Jeanne indicates that both she and the van driver contacted the mother right						
away to let her know what had occurred.						
Staff member Nikki Brown was the van driver on this date transporting 5 school age children to						
school. This was the first day of school for the children. Nikki transports to 5 Elementary schools						
and has a list of children and what schools they attend attached to a clipboard. At 8:20am Nikki pulled up to Skyline Elementary and while doing so had dropped the clipboard under the seat of						
the van. BF stated that this was his school and so Nikki dropped him off without checking the						
clipboard to verify school attendance.						
Jeanne Lush received a phone call at approximately 8:30am from Skyline Elementary indicating						
that BF had been dropped off at the wrong school. Jeanne contacted Nikki (she was still doing						
school runs) who picked up BF at Skyline Elementary and dropped him off at West Dodge Elementary. Jeanne indicates that Nikki was back at Education Express by 9:00am.
