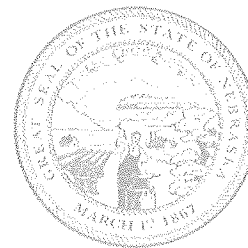

I, TYSON TILTON, hereby state and declare:

1. I am the owner of the above-mentioned childcare program.
2. I have read, understand and agree to comply with all the Regulations Governing Licensure of Family Child Care Home Is, Title 391, as long as I am licensed by the State of Nebraska to provide child care services. Specifically,

NAC 3-006.22B Beds, Cribs, and Sleeping Surfaces: The licensee must ensure that sleeping surfaces appropriate to the child's age and level of development are available for each child in care.

1. Acceptable sleeping surfaces for children over 12 months of age are:
 - a. Beds;
 - b. Cots;
 - c. Cribs;
 - d. Playpens;
 - e. Sofas;
 - f. Washable sleeping bags; and
 - g. Waterproof mats, which must be at least one inch thick and at least 45 inches long.
2. The only acceptable sleeping surfaces for children age 12 months and under are cribs and playpens. When used, cribs and playpens must meet the following standards:

- a. Cribs and playpens must be federally approved;
 - b. Cribs must be equipped with a waterproof crib mattress covered by a fitted sheet. The mattress pad for a playpen must be specifically designed for playpen use and covered by a fitted sheet;
 - c. Cribs and playpens must contain no soft objects, bumper pads, toys, or loose bedding. If a blanket is used, it must be secured or tucked under the crib mattress or the pad of the playpen and reach no higher than the infant's chest; and
 - d. Cribs and playpens must be kept clean, in good repair, and not have any surface covered by lead-based paint.
3. Cribs, playpens, cots, and mats must be separated by at least three feet of space.
 4. Cribs, playpens, cots, and mats must be disinfected daily or marked for individual use and disinfected weekly or more often when needed.
 5. For evening care, each child must be provided with a cot with a waterproof mattress.
 6. The following must not be used as sleeping surfaces:
 - a. The top level of a bunk for children age 5 and under;
 - b. Stackable cribs;
 - c. Waterbeds for children age 3 and under; and
 - d. Cots, cushions, futons, mats, or pillows for infants 12 months and under.

NAC 3-006.23A Infant Care Rooms: Rooms where infants are receiving care must be limited to the care of no more than 12 children at any one time.

1. If five or more infants are receiving care in a room, at least two staff members must be in the room.
2. If nine or more infants are receiving care in a room, at least three staff members must be in the room.
3. Equipment such as cribs with wheels, buggies, wagons, or laundry carts must be available for emergency evacuation unless additional staff above the ratio are available to carry infants.

3. I understand and agree with the following:

- A. I will only use approved sleeping surfaces free of loose objects.
- B. I will ensure the appropriate number of staff will be in the infant care room at all times.
- C. I acknowledge that this Agreement is the result of inspections on August 7, 2017, and May 11, 2018 conducted by Sue Jensen.
- D. This Licensing Agreement will be prominently posted with the current license so it is clearly visible to parents and Department representatives.

- E. That the OCSL shall conduct announced or unannounced monitor visits to my facility to determine compliance with this Agreement.
4. Any violation of this Agreement may be grounds for further negative action or discipline.
5. This Agreement shall be in effect from the signing date for 6 months. Should the license be amended because of a change of address, this Agreement may transfer to the new address if appropriate to the conditions of this Licensing Agreement.
