## LICENSING AGREEMENT

I, Vanelle Littrell/ owned by Maximum Heights Academy LLC, operate Maximum Heights Academy Childcare Center, 6669 Sorenson Pkwy, Omaha, Ne 68152, six days a week, Monday through Saturday, 6:00 AM to 1:00 AM, hereby voluntarily state and declare: I have read and understand the Regulations Governing Licensure of Child Care Centers.

I agree to comply with each of the Child Care Center Regulations, as long as I am licensed by the State of Nebraska to provide Child Care Services.

I understand and agree to comply with:

391 NAC 3-006.19 Adequate and Appropriate Supervision

Adequate and appropriate supervision must be provided to children at all times children are in attendance, including during outdoor play. Ultimate responsibility for supervision rests with the Licensee.

391 NAC 3-006.01 Licensee Requirements (in pertinent part...):

Maintain compliance with all applicable state statutes and child care center regulations

391 NAC 3-006.15B (in pertinent part...):

Each room where children are receiving care must have a teacher who is involved with the direct care of children

During naptime, at least one teacher must be in the room where children are napping, as long as the staff-to-child ratio is maintained center wide

On January 6, 2017, the Office of Children's Services Licensing received a Self-Report from Licensee, which was substantiated for lack of appropriate supervision, as children were left unattended in a room during naptime.

I understand and agree there will be a Teacher in every room providing adequate and appropriate supervision during nap time.

I will ensure that this Licensing Agreement will be prominently posted with the current Child Care License so it is clearly visible to parents and Department representatives.

I understand that Child Care Licensing staff shall conduct announced or unannounced visits to my facility to determine compliance with this Agreement.

Any violation of this Agreement may be grounds for further negative action or discipline as the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health may deem appropriate.

This Agreement is a Licensing Agreement which means that the Department reserves the right to take additional action as deemed appropriate. However, any violation of this Licensing Agreement may be grounds for further negative action or discipline as the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, may deem appropriate.

This Agreement shall be in effect from the signing of this Agreement for six months. Should the Child Care Center be amended due to a change of address, this Agreement may transfer to the new address
