Corrective Action Plan

- 1) A child was left unattended on playground for approximately 10 minutes on March 9, 2017.
- 2) a. We have implemented a tracking sheet the teachers are to fill out when going out to the playground. The Harrison Village Transition Count Procedure is as follows:

Fill in the date and Classroom

Megan Kaup

Fill in children's names who are present

As a child walks out of the room to go to the playground mark them out

As a child enters the playground mark them in

If a child leaves while on the playground write P/U in the in box

If a child gets dropped off while on the playground add them in on the child's name section and write D/O in the In box

Total the children when you get on the playground and again when back in the classroom and initial

Repeat steps for going back into the classroom

- b. The Transition Count Procedure has been added to our New Employee Training Manual
- c. We have also reminded all staff that they need to do a visual sweep of the entire playground before shutting the door to ensure all children have made it inside the building.
- d. We are holding a Playground Safety Training on Thursday, April 27th here at the center taught by Gina Ewing.
- Please see attached Transition Count Checklist Spreadsheet and employee signatures signifying that they understand and will follow the procedures.
- 4) Megan Kaup, Director and Jamie Roschke, Assistant Director are both in charge of monitoring that each classrooms Transition Count Spreadsheet are being utilized. They will do this by visually checking throughout the day while kids are transitioning from the playground as well checking over the logs. The logs will be turned in and filed at the front desk. Tom Wolf, Licensee will be looking through the Transition Count Log Binders to ensure they are being filled out correctly and used during every playground transition.

Dear Tom Wolf, licensee/ Megan Kaup, Director:

Nebraska Revised Statutes, section 71-1911 (4), of the Child Care Licensing Act, provides that the deptarment may place a license on Corrective Action Status... A non-disciplinary probationary license may be issued for the licensee to operate under Corrective Action Status if the department determines that:

- a) The Licensee is unable to comply with all licensure requiremnts and standards or has had a history of noncompliance;
- b) The effect of non compliance with any rule or regulation does not present an unreasonable risk to the health, safety or well-being of children or staff; and

 The Licensee has a written plan of correction that has been approved by the department.

FACTS:

On 3-9-17, A 21 month old male child, was left unattended on the playground for a minimum of 10 minutes and staff directly responsible for supervison were unaware the child was missing.

REGULATORY BASES:

391 NAC 3-006.01 Licensee Requirements:

Ensure the center is administered and managed appropriately.

Maintain compliance with all applicable state statutes and school-age only regulations.

391 NAC 3-006.02 Director Requirements

Be responsible for the center's compliance with rules and regulations.

391 NAC 4-006.19 Supervision of Children

Adequate and appropriate supervision must be provided to children at all times children are in attendance, including during outdoor play. Ultimate responsibility for supervision rests with the licensee.

Based on the facts presented above and the regulations violated, the department is placing your operating license on Corrective Action Status for a period of six (6) months.

Corrective action status is voluntary and the decision regarding the placement on corrective action status is not appealable. However, you are <u>required</u> to submit a written Plan of Correction that <u>must be</u> approved by the department. The following items must be included in your written Plan of Correction:

1) Identification of issue(s) of concern

2) Provisions for how you will correct and maintain compliance;

3) Specify the written documentation to be provided to the Department.

- 4) Identify who is responsible (include position titles) for corrections and maintenance of compliance; and
- 5) Timelines

Please submit your written Plan of Correction to Dawn Kozak Child Care Inspection Specialist, Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Children's Services Licensing, 1313 Farnam Street, 3rd Floor, Omaha, NE 68102 within ten calendar days after you receive this letter.

If you do not submit a written Plan of Correction, or the written Plan of Correction is not approved, the department may discipline your license by imposing one or a combination of the following types of Disciplinary Action:

1. Issue a probationary (disciplinary) license;

2. Suspend or revoke a provisional, probationary, or operating license;

3. Impose a civil penalty of up to five dollars per child, based upon the number of children for which the program is authorized to provide child care effective date of finding violation, for each day the program is in violation;

4. Establish restrictions on new enrollment of the program;

5. Establish restrictions or other limitations on the number of children, or the age of the children served in this program; or

6. Establish other restrictions or limitations on the type of service provided by the program.
