LICENSING AGREEMENT

I, Amy Reuter, Licensee of Amy's Licensed Day Care LLC operating as a Family Child Care Home I license number FI11923 located at 13450 Jamestown Street, Waverly NE. 68462 hereby state and declare:

I have read and understand the Regulations Governing Licensure of Family Child Care Home I Title 391 NAC Chapter 1.

I agree to comply with each of the Family Child Care Home Regulations as long as I am licensed by the State of Nebraska to provide child care services.

I understand that this Licensing Agreement is a result of a provisional to operational licensing visit by Children's Services Licensing staff Marvie Sullivan, Child Care Inspection Specialist (CCIS) on March 21 and 23, 2017. At the visit on March 21, 2017 CCIS, Sullivan counted 9 children in care, 6 toddlers/preschoolers and 3 infants, all under the age of 12 months of age (6 weeks, 6 months, and 7 months) and no school-agers in care. The home can only care for 8 children if 3 infants are in care and of the 3 infants in care 1 must be over 12 months of age.

On March 23, 2017 CCIS, Sullivan counted 7 children in care, 4 toddlers/preschoolers and 3 infants, all under 12 months of age (6 weeks, 6 months, 7 months). When 3 infants are in care 1 of the infants, must be over 12 months of age.

The Family Child Care Home I was in violation of 391-NAC 1-006.08A Licensing Capacity:
"The number of children in care at any one time must not exceed the licensed capacity."

The maximum licensed capacity for a Family Child Care Home I is eight children, except that a licensee may be approved to serve up to two additional school-age children during non-school hours, if no more than two of the other children in care are under 18 months of age."

The Family Child Care Home I was in violation of 391-NAC 1-006.08B Staff-to-Child Ratio:
"The appropriate staff-to-child ratio must be met at all times, as follows."

1. Infants only. If the program provides care to infants only, the following ratios apply:

Number of Infants in Care	Number of Staff Required
4	1
5-8	2

2. Mixed ages. If the program provides care to children of mixed ages, the following ratios apply:

Number of Children in Care	Number of Staff Required
1-8	1
9-10 (9 th and 10 th children must be school-age)	1

- Should the Family Child Care Home I license be amended because of change of address, this Agreement may transfer to the new address if appropriate to the conditions of the Licensing Agreement.
