Good afternoon,

We want to make you aware of upcoming changes to fees for select Nebraska online court services. The Nebraska Supreme Court has approved adjustments that will go into effect on **January 1, 2026**. This will be the first fee update in more than ten years, supporting ongoing system improvements and modernization efforts across the Judicial Branch.

These changes will help enhance system performance, reliability, and overall user experience. Here's a quick summary:

## What is staying the same:

• Fees for Trial and Appellate Court Electronic Filing (eFiling) are not changing. Users will continue to pay only the standard court-required filing fees.

## What is changing:

- Subscriber Case Search: Cost will increase from \$1.00 to \$2.00 per record.
- Bulk Court Record Search: Monthly cost will increase from \$500 to \$1,000, providing access to up to 20,000 records per month.
  - Exceeding the 20,000 record limit will no longer lead to account suspension; however, once the limit is reached, access to each additional case will be billed at \$2.00 per record until the monthly cycle resets at the beginning of the next month.
- New Case Index: Monthly cost will increase from \$1,000 to \$1,200.
- Statewide Case Index: Monthly cost will increase from \$1,500 to \$2,000.
