NOTICE is hereby given that the Nebraska State Patrol will hold rulemaking hearings on Friday, August 28, 2020, beginning at 9:00 a.m. at Nebraska State Patrol Headquarters, 1600 Nebraska Highway 2, Lincoln, Nebraska.

The purpose of these hearings is to take testimony and evidence concerning adoption of proposed changes to the following chapters of Title 272, which will be heard at the times listed below:

9:00 a.m.: Chapter 2 Administration of the Security, Privacy, and Dissemination of the Criminal History Information Act

10:00 a.m.: Chapter 3 Carrier Enforcement Division

11:00 a.m.: Chapter 4 Operations

~~001 RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE, PURPOSE AND CONTENTS OF VIOLATION AND WARNING CARDS, AND THE UNIFORM CITATION AND COMPLAINT~~

~~001.01 Violation Cards~~

~~001.01A The violation card is used by the Nebraska State Patrol, including its Carrier Enforcement Division, for violations of the statutes of Nebraska or the rules and regulations of the Director of Motor Vehicles.~~

~~001.01B When a violation card is issued, the officer shall enter thereon all required information, including the name and address of the driver, the violation, and the date and time of the violation.~~

~~001.01C A motorist issued a violation card is required to correct the violation as soon as possible. The violation card does not constitute permission or authorization to operate the vehicle without correcting the violation within five days allotted to return the card, nor does the violation card authorize or permit the motorist to operate any motor vehicle without carrying their operator's license within the five days allotted to return the card when the violation card is issued for failing to carry or present an operator's license.~~

~~001.01D After the violation has been corrected, the motorist must have a duly authorized state, county or municipal law enforcement officer sign the card, certifying that the violation has been corrected. The card must then be mailed postage prepaid to the Nebraska State Patrol within five days from the day the card was received.~~

~~001.02 Warning Cards~~

~~001.02A The warning card is used by the Nebraska State Patrol, including~~

its Carrier Enforcement Division, for violations where, according to the officer's judgment, the violation does not warrant a citation and complaint in light of the vehicle and operator, the time in which the violation occurred (day or night), the number of other motor vehicles being operated in the immediate area, or the seriousness of the offense.

001.02B When a warning card is issued by the Nebraska State Patrol, the officer shall enter thereon all required information, including the name and address of the violator, the violation and the date and time of the violation.

001.03 Uniform Citation and Complaint

001.03A The Uniform Citation and Complaint is used by the Nebraska State Patrol, except for its Carrier Enforcement Division, for traffic and other violations observed or detected. (Through the use of the Uniform Citation and Complaint,) the violator appears in court in accordance with the notice given to him under the provisions of §§29-423 through 29-426, Neb. Rev. Stat. and §39-667, Neb. Rev. Stat.

001.03B The Uniform Citation and Complaint is used by the Carrier Enforcement Division of the Nebraska State Patrol for violations of the laws specified in §60-1306. (Through the use of the Uniform Citation and Complaint,) the violator appears in court in accordance with the notice given to him under the provisions of §§29-423 through 29-426, Neb. Rev. Stat. and §§60-1307, Neb. Rev. Stat.
