OPINION AND FINDINGS

On December 13, 2016, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission), on its own motion, opened the above-captioned proceeding to amend Title 291, Chapter 3, Motor Carrier rules and regulations, to amend certain provisions of the rules.

In the Order opening the docket and releasing the rules amendments for comment, a deadline for public comment was set for January 13, 2017. On January 4, 2017, a request was filed by Mr. Jack Shultz of O'Neill, Heinrich, Damkroger, Bergmeyer, and Shultz, seeking an extension of the comment period to January 31, 2017. In his request, Mr. Shultz stated that his clients had been out of the country when the Order was released, and therefore need to request more time to prepare comments.
