### BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed December 16, 2019, with the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission"), Calyxt, Inc., ("Applicant") of Roseville, Minnesota, seeks authority to operate as a grain dealer pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat.  $\S$  75-903 (Reissue of 2018) and 291 NAC 8,  $\S$  003 (2016).

Applicant has filed the required application fee and security in the form of a Bond in the amount of \$35,000 in compliance with 291 NAC 8, §\$003.02(D) and 003.04. Such security is for the benefit of any producer within the state who files a valid claim arising from a sale to a grain dealer. Applicant has also filed a financial statement that meets the requirements of 291 NAC 8, § 003.03.

### OPINION AND FINDINGS

Being fully advised in the premise, the Commission finds Calyxt, Inc., has met the requirements of Nebraska law and Commission Rules, and should therefore be issued a grain dealer license.

### ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. GD-3039, be and is hereby, granted, and Calyxt, Inc., is authorized to operate as a licensed grain dealer in the State of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Calyxt, Inc., is hereby issued a grain dealer license that expires June 30, 2021, unless used in a manner inconsistent with Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.
