BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed October 15, 2020, with the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission"), Edgar Grain Company, ("Applicant") of Oak, Nebraska, seeks authority to operate as a grain dealer pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-903 (Reissue of 2018) and 291 NAC 8, § 003 (2016).

Applicant has filed the required application fee and security in the form of an Irrevocable Letter of Credit in the amount of \$123,000 in compliance with 291 NAC 8, §§003.02(D) and 003.04. Such security is for the benefit of any producer within the state who files a valid claim arising from a sale to a grain dealer. Applicant has also filed a financial statement that meets the requirements of 291 NAC 8, § 003.03.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Being fully advised in the premise, the Commission finds Edgar Grain Company, has met the requirements of Nebraska law and Commission Rules, and should therefore be issued a grain dealer license.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. GD-2163, be and is hereby, granted, and Edgar Grain Company, is authorized to operate as a licensed grain dealer in the State of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Edgar Grain Company, is hereby issued a grain dealer license that expires December 31, 2021, unless used in a manner inconsistent with Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.
