## OPINION AND FINDINGS

Upon the verified Complaint of Terri Fritz, Grain Director, Grain Warehouse Department, filed on June 1, 2022, Mercaris Corporation, Silver Spring, Maryland ("Respondent"), is alleged to be in violation of Title 291 Neb. Admin. Code, Chapter 8, § 003.03.

In consideration of the Complaint filed, the Commission is of the opinion and finds consistent with Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-903.01, Respondent shall be required to show cause as to why Respondent should not be assessed civil penalties and revocation of its Grain Dealer License for failing to meet maintain a minimum allowable net worth of \$10,000. Therefore, hearing on this matter shall be held on Wednesday, August 3, 2022 at 10:00 a.m. in the Commission Hearing Room, 1200 N Street, Suite 300, Lincoln, Nebraska.
