BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On May 10, 2022, the Grain Warehouse Department ("Department") of the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") filed a Complaint against Union Grain Company (hereinafter "Respondent") of Saint Libory, Nebraska, seeking to assess civil penalties against Respondent on the grounds that it operated in an oversold, negative position, a violation of Nebraska statutes and regulations.

On May 10, 2022, an Order was entered to show cause and set this matter for hearing on June 29, 2022. Prior to the hearing, the Department and Respondent entered negotiations to resolve this matter. Thereafter, the Parties reached a stipulated agreement. The Parties now request additional time to fulfil the obligations of the stipulated agreement.

Therefore, I find that the hearing scheduled for June 29, 2022, should be, and is hereby, postponed. The hearing will be rescheduled at a later date, if needed.
