The Commission finds that Mid Plains Grain, LLC, Wayne has met the requirements of $\underline{\text{Neb. Rev. Stat.}}$ § 75-903 and applicable sections of Neb. Admin. Code Title 291, Ch. 8, Sec. 003, and therefore, should be issued a grain dealer license.

ORDER
