Upon the verified complaint of John A. Fecht, Director, Warehouse Department, Complainant, Respondent was alleged to be in violation of The Grain Dealer Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-901 et seq. (2008) (The Act) by failing to comply with Commission financial requirements and failing to timely file financial statements.

Respondent signed a stipulation agreeing to pay a civil penalty in the amount of one thousand fifty dollars (\$1050.00). Respondent has returned the signed stipulation and a check in the full amount. Additionally, Respondent has returned its grain dealer license and is pursuing a grain dealer license through a separate entity. Therefore, Complainant recommends that the complaint be dismissed and the hearing previously scheduled for March 6, 2012 be cancelled.

Based upon the stipulation, the Commission finds that the complaint should be dismissed, license GD-2926 be cancelled and the hearing cancelled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the complaint filed against Sunbird, Inc., be dismissed, license GD-2926 be cancelled and the hearing scheduled for March 6, 2012 be cancelled.
