BY THE COMMISSION:

Upon the verified complaint of John A. Fecht, Director, Warehouse Department (Complainant), filed on May 23, 2013, George Pfeifer d/b/a George Pfeifer Trucking, Spencer, Nebraska (Respondent) was alleged to be in violation of The Grain Dealer Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-901 et seq. (2008) (The Act) by failing to timely file financial statements.

Respondent filed the required financial statements on June 10, However, Respondent did not meet financial requirements under the Act. On July 17, 2013, Respondent surrendered his grain dealer license. Therefore, Complainant recommends that the complaint be dismissed.

Due to the surrender of the grain dealer license, Commission finds that the complaint should be dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the complaint filed against George Pfeifer d/b/a George Pfeifer Trucking, Spencer, Nebraska, be dismissed.
