Upon the verified complaint of John A. Fecht, Director, Warehouse Department (Complainant), filed on May 23, 2013, Lackawanna Products Corp., Clarence, New York (Respondent) was alleged to be in violation of The Grain Dealer Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-901 et seq. (2008) (The Act) by failing to timely file financial statements.

Respondent signed a stipulation agreeing to pay a civil penalty in the amount of two hundred ten dollars (\$210.00). Respondent has returned the signed stipulation and a check in the full amount. Therefore, Complainant recommends that the complaint be dismissed.
