Applicant does not seek to register any trucks for use in grain transportation.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Commission finds that Consolidated Grain and Barge Co., Mt. Carroll, IL has met the requirements of $\underline{\text{Neb. Rev. Stat.}}$ § 75-903 and applicable sections of Neb. Admin. Code Title 291, Ch. 8, Sec. 003, and therefore, should be issued a grain dealer license.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Consolidated Grain and Barge Co., Mt. Carroll, IL be issued a grain dealer license.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that such grain dealer license shall expire March 31, 2013, in compliance with Neb. Admin. Code Title 291, Ch. 8, Rule 003.02F (June 2, 2002).
