BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed June 5, 2012, Mid-Iowa Cooperative, Beaman, IA seeks authority as a grain dealer pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. Section 75-903 (Reissue 1996) and Neb. Admin. Code Title 291, Ch. 8, Sec. 003 (June 2, 2002).

Applicant has filed the appropriate annual fee with the Commission. Applicant has filed security in the form of a bond in the amount of \$300,000.00, in compliance with Neb. Admin. Code Title 291, Ch. 8, Rule 003.04. Such security is for the benefit of any producer or owner within the state who files a valid claim arising from a sale to or purchase from a grain dealer. Applicant has also filed a financial statement that meets the requirements of Neb. Admin. Code Title 291, Ch. 8, Rule 003.03. Applicant does not seek to register any trucks for use in grain transportation.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Commission finds that Mid-Iowa Cooperative, Beaman, IA has met the requirements of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-903 and applicable sections of Neb. Admin. Code Title 291, Ch. 8, Sec. 003, and therefore, should be issued a grain dealer license.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Mid-Iowa Cooperative, Beaman, IA be issued a grain dealer license.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that such grain dealer license shall expire June 30, 2013, in compliance with Neb. Admin. Code Title 291, Ch. 8, Rule 003.02F (June 2, 2002).
