#### BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 1, 2017, Able, LLC (Able) surrendered its grain dealer license to the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission). On May 16, 2017, the Commission issued an order setting a hearing for July 12, 2017, to determine security coverage for sellers of grain to Able.

After the surrender of the license, the Commission's Grain Warehouse Department (Department) examined the records of Able and compiled possible claims based upon the information. Individual claim forms were mailed to all claimants identified in the records of Able notifying them of the hearing date. Claimants were asked to return claim forms no later than June 16, 2017, indicating whether they disputed the information and to provide any supporting documentation. Notice of the hearing was also published in several newspapers in the area affected by the closure in addition to the Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska.1 Copies of all claim forms returned by individual claimants prior the date of the hearing, including any supporting documentation provided, were made part of the record.2

Hearing on this matter was held on July 12, 2017, at which time additional evidence was taken with respect to claims against the \$258,000.00 dealer bond pursuant to the Grain Dealer Act.<sup>3</sup>

All claims against the grain dealer bond are listed in Appendix A attached to this order. The prices established for claims for dealers were based upon the actual contract amounts. If grain was not priced, the price was set at \$3.21 per bushel for corn, \$8.75 per bushel for soybeans, and \$3.51 per bushel

for wheat, based on market prices on the date of closure. Check off fees were determined by the May  $1^{\rm st}$  prices, however no other fees have been determined at this time.

### EVIDENCE

Mr. John Fecht, director of the Department testified generally regarding the process used by the Department in compiling possible dealer claims to the security. The original dealer license for Able was included as part of the record.<sup>4</sup> A listing of possible dealer claimants who were sent claim forms in addition to supporting documentation was entered into the record.<sup>5</sup>

For the sake of brevity, the claims may be referred to throughout this order by the number assigned in Appendix A. The number of the dealer claim corresponds to the exhibit number assigned to that claimant's documentation and claim form. The Department sent claim forms to 14 potential claimants. One claimant, Kevin Wheeler, responded he had been paid for his grain and did not have a claim. One claimant disagreed because he had soybeans that were not listed on the original claim. He provided additional documentation and the Department agreed with his assessment. He also provided additional documentation at the hearing. The Commission did not specifically request testimony from any claimants. However, anyone wishing to testify regarding a claim was permitted to do so.

Mr. Wheeler was the only claimant to formally testify in order to provide the above referenced exhibit. Many claimants asked questions of the Department staff.

## OPINION AND FINDINGS

Under its grain dealer license, Able was required to post grain dealer security payable to the Commission for the benefit of any producer or owner within the state who files a valid claim arising from a sale to the grain dealer during the time the bond is in force. Able posted said bond in the amount of \$258,000.00. Pursuant to the Grain Dealer Act:

- (1) No seller shall have recourse to the grain dealer's security unless the seller:
  - (a) Demands payment from the grain dealer within fifteen days after the date of the last shipment of any contract;
  - (b) Negotiates any negotiable instrument issued as payment for grain by the grain dealer within fifteen days after its issuance; and
  - (c) Notifies the commission within fifteen days after any apparent loss to be covered under the terms of the grain dealer's security.
- (2) The grain dealer's security shall provide security for direct delivery grain until any post-direct delivery storage position is created for a period not to exceed fifteen days after the date of the last shipment of the contract.<sup>9</sup>

None of the claims presented to the Commission were within the fifteen day time frame. The most recent load contained within any of the claims was delivered on February 23, 2017. The last date any delivery could be made and the producer eligible for security coverage was April 14, 2017. Therefore, the Commission finds that all thirteen claims upon Able's dealer bond should be denied as the last delivery of grain for each claim was made outside the fifteen days permitted for security coverage.

### ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that claims against the grain dealer bond issued for Able, LLC are denied as outlined herein and set forth in Appendix A.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Commission shall not call the security bond.
