By application filed May 13, 2015 with the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission"), Unruh Trucking, LLC ("Applicant"), of Galva, Kansas, seeks authority to operate as a grain dealer pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-903 (Reissue of 2009) and 297 NAC 8, § 003 (2014).

Applicant has filed the required annual fee and security in the form of an Irrevocable Letter of Credit in the amount of \$109,000, in compliance with 291 NAC 8, § 003.04 (2014). Such security is for the benefit of any producer or owner within the state who files a valid claim arising from a sale to or purchase from a grain dealer. Applicant has also filed a financial statement that meets the requirements of 291 NAC 8, § 003.03. Applicant also proposes to register five (5) trucks for use in grain transportation.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Being fully advised in the premise, the Commission finds Unruh Trucking, LLC of Galva, Kansas, has met the requirements of Nebraska law and Commission Rules, and should therefore be issued a grain dealer license.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. GD-3004, be and is hereby, granted, and Unruh Trucking, LLC, is authorized to operate as a licensed grain dealer in the State of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Unruh Trucking, LLC, is hereby issued a grain dealer license that expires June 30, 2015 unless used in a manner inconsistent with Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.
