ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. GD-3009, be and is hereby, granted, and Dennis Commodities, LLC, is authorized to operate as a licensed grain dealer in the State of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Dennis Commodities, LLC, is hereby issued a grain dealer license that expires September 30, 2016 unless used in a manner inconsistent with Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.
