## BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed August 25, 2017, with the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission"), Lathrop FSG, LLC, ("Applicant") of Mission, Kansas, seeks authority to operate as a grain dealer pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-903 (Reissue of 2009) and 291 NAC 8, § 003 (2014).

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. GD-3024, be and is hereby, granted, and Lathrop FSG, LLC, is authorized to operate as a licensed grain dealer in the State of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Lathrop FSG, LLC, is hereby issued a grain dealer license that expires September 30, 2018, unless used in a manner inconsistent with Nebraska Statutes and the Rules and Regulations of this Commission.
