Upon the verified complaint of John A. Fecht, Director, Warehouse Department, (Complainant), Frontier Trading, Inc., Roff, Oklahoma a/k/a Heartland-Frontier Trading Company and Frontier Trading Company, (Respondent) is alleged to be in violation of the Grain Dealer Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-901 et seq. (2008) (The Act) by operating as a grain dealer without a grain dealer license.

Complainant seeks civil penalties and a cease and desist order pursuant to pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-910 and Neb. Admin. Code, Title 291, Ch. 8 § 003.11. Respondent has not yet been able to provide a reviewed or audited financial statement and the remainder of the application is still being reviewed by the Department. On September 25, 2013, Respondent notified the Department that it had retained a certified public accountant able to review its financials and requested a continuance of the hearing.

Therefore, the Hearing Officer finds that the hearing previously scheduled for October 1, 2013 be continued to allow additional time for the Respondent to come into compliance with licensing requirements and for the Department to review those portions of the Application filed to date.

The Hearing Officer finds that the hearing should be continued to **November 13, 2013 at 1:30 p.m.** in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska immediately following the hearing in Rule/Reg No. 191.
