Upon the verified complaint of John A. Fecht, Director, Warehouse Department, Complainant, Respondent was alleged to be in violation of The Grain Dealer Act, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 75-901 et seq. (2008) (The Act) by engaging in grain dealer activity without a grain dealer license.

Respondent signed a stipulation agreeing to pay a civil penalty in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) and surrendering its grain warehouse license. Respondent has returned the signed stipulation, a check in the full amount, and its grain warehouse license. Therefore, Complainant recommends that the complaint be dismissed.

Based upon the stipulation, the Commission finds that the complaint should be dismissed and the hearing previously scheduled for November 8, 2011 be cancelled.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the complaint filed against M.G. Waldbaum Company d/b/a Wayne Grain and Feed, Wayne, Nebraska, be dismissed and the terms of the stipulation approved.
