BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 30, 2014, 81-20 Grain, LLC, ("81-20" or "Applicant"), of Randolph, Nebraska, filed an application with the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") seeking authority to operate as a grain warehouse in Nebraska pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 88-527 (Reissue of 2008) and 291 NAC 8, § 002 (2014).

Applicant has filed the required annual fee and security in the form of a bond for \$571,500.00, in compliance with 291 NAC 8, § 002.05 (2014). Such security is held for the benefit of all depositors, storers, and/or owners of grain stored in the warehouse and qualified check holders who file a valid claim against the grain warehouse. Further, Applicant has filed a financial statement that satisfies the requirements of 291 NAC 8, § 002.04 (2014).

OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Commission finds that 81-20 has met the requirements of $\underline{\text{Neb.}}$ $\underline{\text{Rev. Stat.}}$ § 88-527 and 291 NAC 8, § 002 (2014), and therefore, should be issued a grain warehouse license.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that 81-20 Grain, LLC, Randolph, be, and is hereby issued a grain warehouse license effective September 30, 2014 pursuant to the above mentioned conditions.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that such grain warehouse license shall expire June 30, 2015, pursuant to 291 NAC 8, § 002.03(D).
