On May 23, 2017, the Director of the Housing and Recreational Vehicle Department (Department) filed a Complaint against Cavalier Homes d/b/a Clayton Tiny Homes, Addison, Alabama (Respondent) seeking to fine Respondent on the grounds that it violated provisions of the Nebraska Uniform Standards for Modular Housing Units Act Neb.
