BY THE COMMISSION:

On May 23, 2017, the Director of the Housing and Recreational Vehicle Department (Department) filed a Complaint against Cavalier Homes d/b/a Clayton Tiny Homes, Addison, Alabama (Respondent) seeking to fine Respondent on the grounds that it violated provisions of the Nebraska Uniform Standards for Modular Housing Units Act Neb. Rev. Stat. § 71-1555 et. seq. (2016 Cum. Supp.) and Title 291 NAC Ch. 13 provisions.

Respondent and the Department Director have entered into a stipulation resolving the allegations and the Respondent has paid a fine. Upon review of the stipulation, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that it should be approved and the Complaint should be dismissed.
