1. Make the following revisions to Title 291, Chapter 14, Sections 001 and 004.

001 SCOPE, DEFINITIONS, AND STATE CODE:

001.03 Standards: Standards for all recreational vehicle types, except park models, dealing with body and frame design, and construction, and with the installation of plumbing, heating, and electrical systems in recreational vehicles approved and adopted by the National Fire Protection Association NFPA 1192 STANDARD ON RECREATIONAL VEHICLES, ~~2011~~ 2015 EDITION, are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference.
