BY THE COMMISSION:

By Application filed August 26, 2019, Three Rivers Energy Company of Winnebago, Nebraska, ("Three Rivers" or "Applicant") seeks to withdraw its authority as a competitive natural gas provider ("CNGP") in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on August 29, 2019. No protests were filed; therefore, this Application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

Applicant was granted authority to operate as a CNGP within the State of Nebraska by the Commission on June 16, 2015, in Commission Docket NG-0081. In an application received on August 26, 2019, Three Rivers requested the withdrawal of its authority as a CNGP within the State of Nebraska. Applicant states that it is no longer in the natural gas business, has no customers in Nebraska, and therefore requests to withdraw its authority.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Three Rivers' request to withdraw its authority as a CNGP should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. NG-103 is hereby granted, and the authority to operate as a competitive natural gas provider previously granted to Three Rivers Energy Company in the State of Nebraska, be, and is hereby, cancelled.
