BY THE COMMISSION:

By Application filed September 9, 2019, nTherm, LLC, of Denver, Colorado, ("nTherm" or "Applicant") seeks to withdraw its authority as a competitive natural gas provider ("CNGP") in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the Application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on September 11, 2019. No protests were filed; therefore, this Application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

Applicant was granted authority to operate as a CNGP within the State of Nebraska by the Commission on October 3, 2017, in Commission Docket NG-0092. In an application received on September 9, 2019, nTherm requested the withdrawal of its authority as a CNGP within the State of Nebraska. As expressed in the Application, nTherm states it has decided not to enter the Nebraska market at this time, has no customers in Nebraska, and therefore has determined it is in its best interest to withdraw its certificate of authority in Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that nTherm's request to withdraw its authority as a CNGP should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. NG-104 is hereby granted, and the authority to operate as a competitive natural gas provider previously granted to nTherm, LLC, in the State of Nebraska, be, and is hereby, cancelled.
