BY THE COMMISSION:

By Application filed February 24, 2020, Emporia Renewable Energy Corp. of Littleton, Colorado ("Applicant"), requests cancellation of its authority to operate as a competitive natural gas provider ("CNGP") in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in The Daily Record, Omaha, Nebraska, on February 26, 2020. No protests or interventions were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

By virtue of the authority granted by the Commission in Docket No. NG-97, Applicant was granted a certificate of authority to operate as a competitive natural gas provider ("CNGP") within the State of Nebraska. Applicant now seeks to withdraw its certificate of authority, as it never began doing business within Nebraska and has no customers within Nebraska.

Upon consideration of the request and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds the request to be reasonable and finds that Applicant's Certificate of Authority to operate as a CNGP should be cancelled.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. NG-105 is hereby granted, and the Certificate of Authority previously granted to Emporia Renewable Energy Corp. to operate as a competitive natural gas provider in the State of Nebraska is hereby cancelled.
