### BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed April 9, 2020, KALM Energy, LLC of Lincoln, Nebraska ("Applicant") seeks authority to operate as a competitive natural gas provider ("CNGP") in the State of Nebraska. Notice of the application was published in the *Daily Record*, Omaha, Nebraska, on April 14, 2020. No protests were filed; therefore, this application is processed pursuant to the Commission's Rule of Modified Procedure.

#### OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 66-1848 and 66-1849. Section 66-1849(1) provides in part:

The commission shall certify all competitive natural gas providers and aggregators providing natural gas services. In an application for certification, a competitive natural gas provider or aggregator shall reasonably demonstrate managerial, technical, and financial capability sufficient to obtain and deliver the services such provider or aggregator proposes to offer. The Commission may establish reasonable conditions or restrictions on the certificate at the time of issuance.

In addition, Commission Rules and Regulations specify requirements for an application for authority as a CNGP. See 291 Neb. Admin. Code 9-011.

Applicant is a Nebraska limited liability company, holding its principal office in Lincoln, Nebraska. Applicant submitted this CNGP application for the purpose of selling natural gas through a pipeline owned by Black Hills Nebraska Gas to certain customers. Applicant states that it intends to purchase natural

gas from Northern Natural Gas, which would be delivered to Applicant's customers through Black Hills' pipeline.

In support of its application, Applicant submitted an organizational chart, a certificate of good standing to conduct business in Nebraska, its Articles of Organization, and its 2019 balance sheet. In addition, Applicant submitted information regarding its members and staff's operational ability. There have not been any legal actions or formal complaints pertaining to the provision of competitive natural gas services filed against Applicant within the twelve months prior to filing this application, nor has Applicant had a license or certificate to supply competitive natural gas service revoked, denied or withdrawn.

Commission Staff Accountant, Steve Stovall, submitted his Direct Testimony and a Report on Regulatory Compliance, indicating that the financial statements submitted by Applicant provide evidence of adequate financial resources necessary to obtain and deliver the services that Applicant proposes to offer.

Based upon the information provided in the application and verified by affidavit, the Commission finds that the provisions of Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 66-1848 and 66-1849 and applicable Commission Rules and Regulations are met. Applicant's application for authority should be granted, and Applicant should be issued a certificate of authority as a competitive natural gas provider consistent with the conditions set forth in this order.

#### ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Application No. NG-106 is hereby granted, and Emporia is authorized to operate as a competitive natural gas provider within the State of Nebraska.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this order be made the Commission's official certificate of authority to furnish the service authorized herein as competitive natural gas provider.
