BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

The Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission"), on its own motion, opened the above-captioned investigation for the purpose of gathering information regarding, and reviewing the administration of, customer choice programs for natural gas service offered within the State of Nebraska.

Previously in this docket, on March 10, 2020, I ordered that a workshop in this proceeding be set for Wednesday, June 17, 2020, in the Commission Hearing Room, Lincoln, Nebraska. Since the entry of that order, the Commission has limited public access to its offices in order to comply with local Directed Health Measures and current Centers for Disease Control guidelines regarding the COVID-19 pandemic. In accordance with these measures, I find that the June 17 workshop scheduled in this matter should be conducted electronically.

The workshop in this matter is hereby set for **Wednesday, June 17, 2020, via videoconference, from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. CDT**. No quorum of the public body will be physically present together, and there will be no public in-person attendance. Remote access to the workshop will be available via Zoom.
