BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On September 3, 2020, Heartland Natural Gas, LLC, Lincoln, Nebraska ("Heartland," "HNG," "or "Complainant") filed a formal complaint with the Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") against Black Hills Nebraska Gas, LLC, Rapid City, South Dakota ("Black Hills" or "Respondent") pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stats. §§ 66-1811 and 66-1849(2), and 291 Neb. Admin. Code § 1-004.03. On September 17, 2020, the Nebraska Public Advocate ("PA") filed a petition for informal intervention.

On December 9, 2020, the Complainant in this matter filed a motion for leave to withdraw the complaint. This motion stated that the parties have reached a settlement of this matter, and that the parties jointly seek for the complaint to be dismissed without prejudice.

Upon review of the facts presented and all applicable statutes and regulations, the Commission finds that the motion to withdraw the complaint should be granted, and this matter should be dismissed without prejudice.





O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the motion to withdraw this complaint is granted, and this matter is dismissed without prejudice.
