BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On May 14, 2019, The Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission"), on its own motion, opened this docket in order to monitor issues faced by the Nebraska natural gas industry and Nebraska jurisdictional utilities outside individually docketed proceedings. The purpose of this investigatory docket is to allow regular status updates and meetings between the Commission's Natural Gas Department ("Department"), Nebraska's natural gas public utilities ("utilities"), and the Public Advocate. The above-captioned subdocket, NG-101.1, specifically addresses issues pertaining to Black Hills/Nebraska Gas Utility Company, LLC, and Black Hills Gas Distribution, LLC, d/b/a Black Hills Energy ("Black Hills").

Following consultation with the parties, I find that the next meeting in NG-101.1 should be held on **Tuesday, April 20, 2021, at 2:30 p.m. Central Time**. The meeting will be held in the Commission Hearing Room, 1200 N Street, Suite 300, Lincoln, Nebraska. Zoom webconference access will also be made available to the parties.

On August 4, 2020, the Commission entered an order in this docket requiring Black Hills to submit certain information related to customer disconnections one week prior to the quarterly meeting in this docket. This quarter's report will be due on **Tuesday, April 13, 2021, before 5:00 p.m. Central Time**.

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Parties are to submit in writing all other items to be included on the meeting agenda no later than **Tuesday, April 13, 2021, before 5:00 p.m. Central Time**. Submissions may be made electronically to psc.naturalgas@nebraska.gov. If any party wishes for a submitted agenda item to be marked as a Confidential Item, that item must be clearly marked when submitted to the Commission for inclusion on the agenda.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Hearing Officer that a meeting in the above-captioned matter shall be held on **Tuesday, April 20, 2021, at 2:30 p.m. Central Time** in the Commission Hearing Room, 1200 N Street, Suite 300, Lincoln, Nebraska.
