O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On February 19, 2019, the Nebraska Public Power District (NPPD), Columbus, filed an application seeking authority to construct, operate and maintain an electric transmission lines in Lincoln, Logan, Thomas, Blaine, Loup, Garfield, Holt, and Wheeler Counties having a voltage in excess of 700 volts.

The Commission entered an order granting the application on April 16, 2019. Pursuant to the order, NPPD has until April 16, 2021, to complete the project approved in the application.

On February 16, 2021, NPPD notified the Commission via e-mail that the authorized construction had not been completed due to a pending court case and requested a 12-month extension of time to complete the project and estimates the project will be in service by Spring of 2022.

After due consideration of NPPD's request and pursuant to 291 NAC 7 Sec. 002.07A, which authorizes extensions, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that NPPD's request should be granted and that the authority previously granted in Application No. E-2463 be extended to April 16, 2022.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that Nebraska Public Power District's request for an extension of the authority granted in Application No. E-2463 to April 16, 2022, is hereby granted.
