O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

On February 18, 2020, the Lincoln Electric System, (LES), Lincoln, filed an application with the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) seeking authority to construct, operate and maintain an electric transmission line in Lancaster County having a voltage in excess of 700 volts.

The Commission entered an order granting the application on March 3, 2020. Pursuant to the order, LES has until March 3, 2022, to complete the project approved in the application.

On January 31, 2022, LES notified the Commission via e-mail that the authorized construction had not been completed. LES stated it was waiting for additional preparation work in the project area, unknown at the time of the original application, to be completed to proceed with the E-2469 project. LES has requested a three-month extension to complete the project and estimates the project will be in service by June 1, 2022.

After due consideration of LES's request and pursuant to 291 NAC 7 Sec. 002.07A, which authorizes extensions, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that LES's request should be granted and that the authority previously granted in Application No. E-2469 be extended to June 1, 2022.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Lincoln Electric System's request for an extension of the authority granted in Application No. E-2469 to June 1, 2022, is hereby granted.
