## OPINION AND FINDINGS

On November 17, 2015, the Lincoln Electric System, Lincoln, filed application with the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) seeking authority to construct, operate and maintain an electric transmission line in Lancaster County, Nebraska, having a voltage in excess of 700 volts.

On December 8, 2015, this application was granted and Applicant was duly notified that such action had been taken.

On May 10, 2018, Applicant notified this Commission by mail that the authorized construction had not been completed and Applicant requested a 6 month extension of time be granted for the completion of this line construction as submitted under the original application.

After due consideration of Applicant's request and being fully advised in the premises, the pursuant to Rule 002.07C of the Commission's Rules and Regulations, which authorizes this action, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that Applicant's request should be granted and that the authority granted in Application No. E-2409 be extended for a period of 6 months to June 8, 2018.

## ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Applicant's request be and it is hereby granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the authority granted in Application No. E-2409 be extended and that the Lincoln Electric System, be given an extension of time to June 8, 2018, to complete the construction of the electric transmission line in Lancaster County, Nebraska.
