## BY THE COMMISSION:

The Commission has received an invoice dated November 2, 2009, from Harding & Shultz (HS) associated with the above-captioned docket, totaling \$3,069.16. Commission staff has reviewed the invoice and found it to conform to the Agreement for the Base Public Advocate Services dated November 15, 2008, between the Commission and Harding & Shultz. Commission staff recommends the Commission approve assessment of the expenses, reflected on the invoice from Kinder Morgan, Inc., n/k/a/ Source Gas Distribution, LLC (SourceGas), pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. sec. 66-1840.

#### OPINION AND FINDINGS
