On April 15, 2009, the Nebraska Public Service Commission (Commission) received a formal complaint from Tim Edens (Complainant) against NorthWestern Corp. d/b/a NorthWestern Energy (Respondent).

On or about May 13, 2009, Respondent filed an Answer. A planning conference was held on May 27, 2009. As a result of the planning conference, several issues were decided. Therefore, this order serves to memorialize those decisions and to provide a timeline for proceeding in this docket.

Parties have agreed that no discovery requests or depositions are necessary.

The hearing in Formal Complaint No. FC-1333 will be held on **June 22, 2009, at 1:00 p.m.** in the Commission Hearing Room, 300 The Atrium, 1200 N Street, Lincoln, Nebraska and via video conference at the Education Service Unit #16, Distance Learning Room, 1221 W. 17th Street, North Platte, Nebraska.

Should the parties wish to submit affidavits in lieu of live testimony, each shall notify the Commission in writing no later than **June 3, 2009**. Affidavits must include all relevant exhibits and must be notarized. If parties choose to proceed with the submission of affidavits, all affidavits must be filed with the Commission and served on the other party via first class mail no later than 5:00 p.m. on **June 15, 2009**.

Should the parties wish to proceed to hearing, each party shall file an exhibit and witness list with the Commission, including copies of all exhibits to be presented at the hearing no later than 5:00 p.m. on **June 15, 2009**. Copies of the exhibit and witness lists and the exhibits shall be served on the opposing party via first class mail.

The Complainant will present his case first, followed by the Respondent. The Complainant may request time for rebuttal at the conclusion of the Respondent's witnesses. Each party shall have the opportunity to present witnesses on their behalf. All witnesses will be subject to cross examination by the opposing party and questions from the Commission and Commission staff.
