BY THE COMMISSION:

On or about March 18, 2008, Aquila, Inc., d/b/a Aquila (Aquila) filed proposed changes in tariffs to become effective on April 1, 2008. The proposed changes reflected in Index Nos. 2, 13, 15 and 16 (Tariff Changes) are sought to comply with the Commission's July 24, 2007 Order, in *In the Matter of Aquila, Inc. d/b/a Aquila Networks (Aquila), Omaha, seeking individual rate increases for Aquila's Rate Area One, Rate Area Two, and Rate Area Three*, Application No. NG-0041. That Order was affirmed by Lancaster County District Court by decision issued February 29, 2008.

Aquila further requested that the Tariff Changes become effective on less than 30 days notice, so that the affected customers can begin receiving the benefit of lower rates as soon as possible.

O P I N I O N A N D F I N D I N G S

The State Natural Gas Regulation Act provides:

Unless the commission otherwise orders, no jurisdictional utility shall make effective any changed rate or any term or condition of service pertaining to the service or rates of such utility, except by filing the same with the commission at least thirty days prior to the proposed effective date. The commission, for good cause, may allow such changed rate or any term or condition of service pertaining to the service or rates of any such utility, to become effective on less than thirty days' notice.

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Neb. Rev. Stat. § 66-1808(2).

Because the Tariff Changes comply with a prior Commission order, and for the purpose of expedited use of approved rates, the Commission finds that good cause is present and that the Tariff Changes should become effective on April 1, 2008, as requested by Aquila.

O R D E R

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the proposed tariff changes reflected by the revised Index Nos. 2, 13, 15 and 16 shall become effective on April 1, 2008.
