#### BY THE HEARING OFFICER:

On May 29, 2009, Black Hills/Nebraska Gas Utility Company LLC, d/b/a Black Hills Energy ("Black Hills"), filed a Third Revised Tariff Sheet, Index No. 8, Purchased Gas Cost Adjustment ("PGA"), seeking to add provisions providing for an Annual Retail Service Credit. The revised tariff pages were set to become effective on July 1, 2009.

On June 19, 2009, Roger P. Cox, the Nebraska Public Advocate, ("PA") filed a Petition for Formal Intervention and Request to Suspend Operation of Proposed Tariff Changes.

The Nebraska Public Service Commission ("Commission") opened the above-captioned proceeding to review the Revised Tariff Sheet filed by Black Hills on May 29, 2009, and suspending the proposed Black Hill tariff provisions until further Order of the Commission.

#### Planning Conference
