BY THE COMMISSION:

The Commission received a letter from Harding & Shultz dated August 14, 2009, for Public Advocate's Consultant services cost associated in the above-captioned docket, totaling \$2,811.00. The Commission entered a Notice of Assessment on June 23, 2009. Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. section 66-1840, the commission may begin assessing expenses three business days after the commission gives the utility notice of the assessment by United States mail. The total fees incurred after June 26, 2009, total \$1,201.00. Commission staff has reviewed the invoice and found them to conform to the Agreement dated November 15, 2008, between the Commission and Harding & Shultz. Commission staff recommends the Commission approve assessment of the expenses reflected on the invoice against Black Hills Energy (Black Hills) pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. sec. 66-1840.
