BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 8, 2008, Seminole Energy Services, LLC (Seminole), Lakewood, Colorado, filed a Petition to Withdraw Authority Originally Granted to Midwest United Energy (MUE).

On February 3, 2004, MUE was granted competitive natural gas provider (CNGP) status in the state of Nebraska in accordance with $\underline{\text{Neb}}$. $\underline{\text{Rev}}$. $\underline{\text{Stat}}$. sec. 66-1848-66-1849 (2003 Supp.) and 291 Nebraska Administrative Code, Chapter 9, Rule 009.

On July 1, 2006, Seminole purchased assets of MUE, including MUE's CNGP authority. In Seminole's 2007 Annual CNGP Revenue Report filed at the Commission on behalf of MUE, Seminole stated that it will not use MUE's CNGP authority in the future, but will conduct all CNGP activity under the CNGP authority of Seminole Energy Services, LLC.

OPINION AND FINDINGS

The Commission finds that it has jurisdiction pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 66-1848 to 66-1849 (2003 Supp.).

The Petition to Withdraw should be granted, and MUE's certificate of authority issued February 3, 2004, as a competitive natural gas provider should be of no further force or effect.

ORDER

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Nebraska Public Service Commission that the Petition to Withdraw Authority Originally Granted to Midwest United Energy is hereby granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of authority issued to Midwest United Energy on February 3, 2004, as a competitive natural gas provider should be of no further force or effect
