BY THE COMMISSION:

The Commission has received an invoice from Harding & Shultz dated July 1, 2009, for costs associated with the above-captioned docket, totaling \$73.50. Commission staff has reviewed the invoice and found it to conform to the Agreements for the Base Public Advocate Services dated November 15, 2008, between the Commission and Harding & Shultz & Downs.

Effective May 14, 2007, the Nebraska Certificate of Convenience and utility assets of Kinder Morgan, Inc., were transferred to SourceGas Distribution, LLC (SourceGas), in accordance with approval rendered by this Commission in Application No. NG-0039.¹ Commission staff recommends the Commission approve assessment of the expenses reflected on the invoice to SourceGas, pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. sec. 66-1840.
